- Member of English language program and international education communities



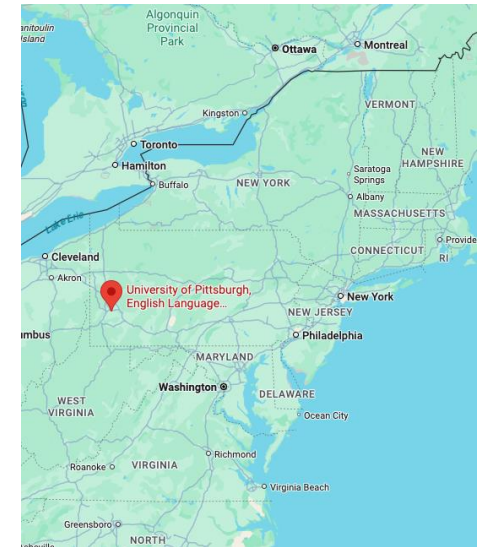
ELI Services

ELI Activities

- Provide opportunities to use English outside of the classroom
 - University events and activities
 - University clubs
 - ELI planned activities
 - Local volunteer opportunities



Intensive English Program (IEP)

- IEP sessions begin three times a year: September, January, May
- Each session is 13 weeks, 20 hours per week
- Classes meet Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday
- Classes in Speaking, Listening, Reading, Writing, and Grammar
- Full-time students: 20 class hours per week
- I-20s issued by the ELI for full-time language study
- Multiple levels of proficiency
- Placement test used to assign students to levels
- Admission to the ELI does **not** include admission to a degree program at the University of Pittsburgh.

IEP Continued

- Housing: Students can arrange housing with:
 - Local homestay organizations
 - Nearby apartments
 - Student residence hall in Downtown Pittsburgh
 - University of Pittsburgh Housing (May – August only)
- Tuition and Fees for AY27
 - Full-time \$6640
 - Part-time (per class) \$1328
 - University fees \$499*(AY26)

Professional and Academic English Program (PAEP)

- Summer-only program, June - July
- 6 weeks, 20 class hours per week
- Classes are Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday
- I-20s issued for language study by the ELI. If a student has also been accepted to a graduate program, the ELI can transfer the visa to the relevant university.

Custom Programs

The ELI is able to create custom programs:

- American English and Culture
- English as an Additional Language Teacher Training
- English and content areas – examples from past programs include:
 - Bioethics
 - Medicine
 - Football
 - Law
 - First Responders

University Fees and IDs

- Free City of Pittsburgh bus pass
- Access to computer labs, software, and tech support
- Access to University of Pittsburgh gyms
- Access to Pitt's Student Health Services
- Access to the University Library System
- Free admission to many of Pittsburgh's popular museums (Fall and Spring)
